



## All Ireland Scholarships

## Northern Ireland

Established by JP McManus in 2008, the All Ireland Scholarship is awarded to 125 of the highest – achieving students per year, with a minimum of two students from each of the 32 counties. The scholarship consists of payments of £5,500 per annum for the duration of the students' undergraduate degree.

To be eligible you must meet the criteria listed below.



## AM I ELIGIBLE?

- You must have been in receipt of the Education Maintenance Allowance
- You must be attending a grant aided post primary school or further education college
- You must sit a minimum of three A Level Examinations, or have completed a Level 3 Extended Diploma at a Further Education College in Northern Ireland for the first time
